


















# Swimming pool unloading and lifting instructions.

	<p>All lifting should be done using the side hooks. Do not use hooks for lifting which are used for fastening the pool in place.</p>		<p>Do not use chains! Use straps instead. Straps should be longer than 4 meters. All water should be removed before lifting the pool.</p>
	<p>When there are more than one pool. Use additional straps to unload and lift pools.</p>		<p>Do not use straps for lifting that are used for fastening pools.</p>
			
	<p>Put tires in a row under the side off the swimming pool when you want to turn over it.</p>		<p>Put tires on each corner off the swimming pool.</p>
	<p>After receiving the pool, remove the protective film.</p>		<p>Place carton between pool and straps for protection.</p>
	<p>All swimming pools should be stored on even surface.</p>		<p>Place a tire under the drain.</p>
			<p>When the pools are stacked, between each pool there should be placed 30 cm height foam on each corner. Protective material should be placed on sides.</p>
